


STOP ASIAN HATE

THE RECENT ATTACKS ON THREE ASIAN-OWNED MASSAGE PARLORS IN ATLANTA SENSELESSLY ENDED THE LIVES OF EIGHT PEOPLE, INCLUDING SIX WOMEN OF ASIAN DESCENT. WE ARE DEEPLY SADDENED AND ALARMED BY THESE ATTACKS AND RECOGNIZE THEIR CONNECTION TO THE BROADER PATTERN OF RACIALLY MOTIVATED HARM AND ABUSE PERPETRATED AGAINST ASIAN AMERICAN PACIFIC ISLANDER (AAP) COMMUNITIES IN THE UNITED STATES.

THE PRSA SAN FRANCISCO BAY AREA CHAPTER STANDS IN SOLIDARITY WITH OUR AAPI COLLEAGUES AND FRIENDS. AS COMMUNICATORS AND AS HUMANS, WE ENDEAVOR THROUGH OUR INDIVIDUAL AND COLLECTIVE ACTIONS TO DO OUR PART TO BRING ABOUT A MORE JUST AND INCLUSIVE WORLD AND STAND UP AGAINST ACTS OF VIOLENCE AND DEHUMANIZATION.

LONG AFTER THE MEDIA ATTENTION AROUND THESE ATTACKS FADES, WE REMAIN COMMITTED TO LIVING UP TO OUR CRUCIAL TENANT OF DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION. WE EMBRACE THIS RESPONSIBILITY AS WE SUPPORT THE AAPI COMMUNITIES.








2021 Recruitment Happy Hour
